APPLICATION INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS 2012-2013

APPLICATION PROCESS

In order to be considered for admission to the University, international applicants should submit the following items prior to the deadline:

APPLICATION DEADLINES

COLLEGE OF ARTS & SCIENCES

March 1ST for the SUMMER or FALL TERM
September 1ST for the SPRING TERM.

COLLEGE OF PHARMACY

TBA

Students have found it beneficial in expediting passport procedures to have these requirements satisfied from six to twelve months prior to their intended date of departure.

A. Application for Admission

Applicant Type:

First-Time Freshman Applicants

- 1) Secondary School Record in English
- 2) Letter of Recommendation from a secondary school official
- 3) ACT/SAT Results (*if available*)
- 4) Non-English speaking natives are required to submit TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score
- 5) Original certificate of national examination taken by the student (*if applicable*)

Transfer Applicants

a) College of Art & Sciences and College of Pharmacy

- 1) **Official transcripts from all post-secondary schools.** *If an applicant has had previous college work outside the United States, the applicant must have his/her records evaluated by a U.S foreign credential evaluation service.* You must contact the agency and request the necessary forms. When we receive an evaluation of your records from them, we will be able to determine what credits we will accept toward your intended major. The agency we recommend is:

b) College of Arts & Sciences

- 2) If not currently enrolled in college, submit a resume or statement of activities
- 3) Submit a high school transcript if less than 20 credit hours of college work

c) College of Pharmacy

- 1) Submit all required documents by the published deadlines located on the College of Pharmacy web page: <http://www.xula.edu/cop/prospective-selection.php>.

B. Xavier University "Certificate of Financial Support"- a notarized form indicating who will pay the cost of attendance.

C. Non- U. S. applicants who do not have a "Green Card" or "Naturalized Citizenship" must include their foreign home address on the Application for Admission.

Provisions should also be made for expenses such as clothing, personal items, bed linens, laundry, recreation and travel. Residence halls are closed when school is not in session: for approximately four weeks during the semester break (December to January) and approximately one month during the summer. Other accommodations must be sought for these periods and this factor should be considered when determining total expenses for the year. **Only U. S. citizens and those who have been issued Green Cards (*permanent residents*) are eligible for federal financial aid, the primary source of financial assistance.** Scholarships are available to a limited number of academically qualified applicants.

AFTER ACCEPTANCE TO XAVIER

After being admitted to the University, eligible students will be issued the **Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20)** as required by the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Service (USCIS). Applicants who have a valid "**Green Card**" or who are "**Naturalized Citizens**" do not need the **Certificate of Eligibility (Form I-20)**. For information related to applying for your student Visa and required SEVIS fees should refer to the USCIS web site at http://travel.state.gov/visa/temp/types/types_1268.html. Information on orientation and registration at Xavier will be sent to all admitted students. It is advisable for students to begin their course of study during the Fall semester in order that they may take required courses in proper sequence. Xavier University offers further information for international students through our [Center for Intercultural and International Programs](#).

There are two mandatory requirements that you must complete and submit to Student Health Service prior to registration – 1) Health Clearance and 2) Insurance Information. Each new student must submit the health forms required by the Xavier University Health Services Office: http://www.xula.edu/student-health/documents/health_assessment.pdf. All undergraduate students are required to carry an insurance which provides coverage for physicians and emergency rooms in the New Orleans area. Information about the student health insurance requirement is located on the Student Health Services web page.
