■ **Briefly:** Fourth game in six days for the Gold Nuggets but their first home game in 36 days . . . It's the first game in 14 days for Lindsey Wilson.

■ **Series:** First meeting. The Gold Nuggets are 2-0 against current members of the Mid-South Conference (1-0 Rio Grande, 1-0 West Virginia Tech). XU will play another Mid-South member, Campbellsville, at 1 p.m. Sunday at The Barn.

■ **Rankings:** Lindsey Wilson and Xavier were among "others receiving votes" in the NAIA Division I coaches poll of December 14. Lindsey Wilson was 26th with 45 points, and Xavier was 27th with 36 points. The next poll will be announced January 11.

■ **Most Recently:** XU was 1-2 in the Surf City Classic at Irvine, Calif., and Brittany Powell was selected to the all-tournament team . . . Lindsey Wilson got 18 points, six assists and a season-high four steals from Sierra Rambert in an 88-53 home victory against Midway on December 19.

■ **Comes From a Good Home:** Xavier has 80 victories in its past 84 games at The Barn but lost 69-66 to Langston in its most recent home game November 27. In conference games the Nuggets have won three straight, 15 of their past 16 and 48 of their past 50.

■ **Next:** Both teams will play at 1 p.m. Sunday . . . The Nuggets will play Campbellsville at The Barn . . . Lindsey Wilson will remain in New Orleans and play Loyola.
