## Women's Basketball

### Today's Game:

Xavier Gold Nuggets (7-4) vs. Campbellsville Lady Tigers (12-1)  
 Sunday, January 3, 2010, 1 p.m.  
 The Barn (capacity 1,300), New Orleans

- **Briefly:** Fifth game in seven days for the Gold Nuggets, who play at home for the second straight day . . . Campbellsville has won five straight since its only loss, 90-70 at defending NAIA Division I national champion Union (Tenn.) on Dec. 5 . . . Xavier held double-digit leads in each of its past three losses.
- **Series:** First meeting. The Gold Nuggets are 2-1 against current members of the Mid-South Conference (1-0 Rio Grande, 1-0 West Virginia Tech, 0-1 Lindsey Wilson).
- **Rankings:** Campbellsville was 10th in the most recent NAIA Division I coaches poll, released December 14. Xavier was among "others receiving votes" — 27th with 36 points. The next poll will be announced January 11.
- **Most Recently:** Both teams played Saturday in New Orleans . . . Lindsey Wilson outscored XU 10-0 in the final 6:22 to rally for a 53-51 victory at The Barn. The Nuggets shot a season-low 30 percent from the floor and were 1-of-14 from 3-point range . . . Campbellsville trailed 29-16 late in the first half at NAIA No. 21 Loyola but roared back for an 83-73 victory at The Den. Whitney Ballinger, a second-team NAIA All-American this past season, had 40 points, 13 rebounds and seven blocked shots.
- **Searching For a Home Security System:** Xavier has 80 victories in its past 85 games at The Barn but dropped the past two in its campus gym — by a combined five points — for the first time since February 2002. In conference games the Nuggets have won three straight, 15 of their past 16 and 48 of their past 50.
- **Next:** Xavier, third in the Gulf Coast Athletic Conference a year ago, will open its GCAC schedule at 5:30 p.m. Thursday at LSU-Shreveport . . . Campbellsville will play host to Olivet Nazarene at 7 p.m. Friday.

January 3, 1995

XU had five double-figure scorers in a 90-39 victory against Olivet Nazarene at The Barn. Antasha Jones led the Gold Nuggets with 21 points, and Cassee Davis had 16 points and 13 rebounds. ONU shot 20 percent from the floor and committed 31 turnovers.
