### Today's Game:

Xavier Gold Nuggets (13-5) vs. Loyola Wolfpack (10-6)  
 Monday, January 25, 2010, 5:30 p.m.  
 The Barn (capacity 1,300), New Orleans

■ **Briefly:** Xavier, leader by two games in the Gulf Coast Athletic Conference, meets the three-time defending GCAC regular-season champion . . . Loyola senior Trenese Smith leads the GCAC with 16.4 points per game and is a three-time GCAC Player of the Year . . . XU is shooting 79.7 percent from the line in January.

■ **Series:** This is the 31st meeting. Xavier leads 25-5, but it's 4-4 the past three seasons. The teams split a pair in 2009 — XU won 49-42 at The Barn on Jan. 29, and Loyola won 66-51 at The Den on Feb. 4 . . . Xavier will visit Loyola on Feb. 18, two days after Mardi Gras.

■ **Rankings:** Loyola was 24th, and Xavier was among "others receiving votes" (29th place, 27 points) in the NAIA Division I coaches poll of Jan. 18. The next rankings were to be released late this afternoon — too late for inclusion in these game notes.

■ **Most Recently:** Both teams played GCAC home games Saturday . . . Xavier got 27 points from Brittany Powell and 14 from Christina Warren in a 71-46 victory over William Carey at The Barn . . . Loyola shot 30.9 percent from the floor but still rallied from a 16-point deficit for a 54-48 victory over Dillard at The Den.

■ **Comforts of Home:** Xavier has 82 victories in its past 88 games at The Barn. In conference games the Gold Nuggets have won five straight, 17 of their past 18 and 50 of their past 52.

■ **Double Duty:** XU's Brittany Powell received two player-of-the-week awards today — from the GCAC and on the state level from the Louisiana Sports Writers Association — after averaging 28 points in two games.

■ **Next:** GCAC home games for both at 5:30 p.m. Thursday — XU vs. Belhaven, and Spring Hill vs. Loyola.

Xavier got 16 points from Antasha Jones and 21 rebounds from Adecia Spain in a 62-54 GCAC victory over Louisiana College at The Barn. Four Nuggets scored in double figures. Vashita Wells had 13 points and five steals, Nicole Stovall scored 11, and Cassee Davis had 10.
