The Business Division has an articulation agreement with the A.B. Freeman School of Business at Tulane University for a Master of Business Administration (MBA) Degree program and Master of Science (MS) Degree programs in Accounting and Finance. It is a specialized program offering preferential admission designed for undergraduate Xavier University students who desire focused and advanced training in business. Xavier students who qualify for these graduate programs receive fellowships that may include full-tuition waiver.
