

Core Curriculum Enhancement (CCE) - Workshop

Description: A Faculty Consultant representative from the Association for Interdisciplinary Studies will lead Xavier Faculty in a workshop designed to increase the depth and breadth of interdisciplinary course offerings. At this workshop Xavier faculty will read, discuss, and utilize scholarship and infuse this knowledge into a core curriculum course with the following course objectives:

*Students will be able to offer explanation of phenomena using knowledge from multiple disciplines

AND

*Students will be able to offer solutions to problems synthesizing multiple disciplinary methods

The workshop will take place April 22, 2017 in the CAT+FD Mellon Seminar Room from 10-4. The workshop will be limited to 10 faculty members. Each participant will be compensated \$500.

1. Description of a course to which a new interdisciplinary approach will be applied. Your proposal can be for an entirely new course or an existing one that would benefit from adaptation. Explanation of the methods by which disciplinary knowledge or methods included in the course description but outside the scope of your educational and professional training or publication record will be supplied. (250 words)
2. Justification for this new interdisciplinary approach and specific anticipated course improvements. (250 words)
3. Description of personal, pedagogical, and or research related motivation for this endeavor and of your commitment to disseminating your interdisciplinary experience and expertise within your department and/or division. (250 words)
