CUR: How does this proposal fit into your academic and social schedule?

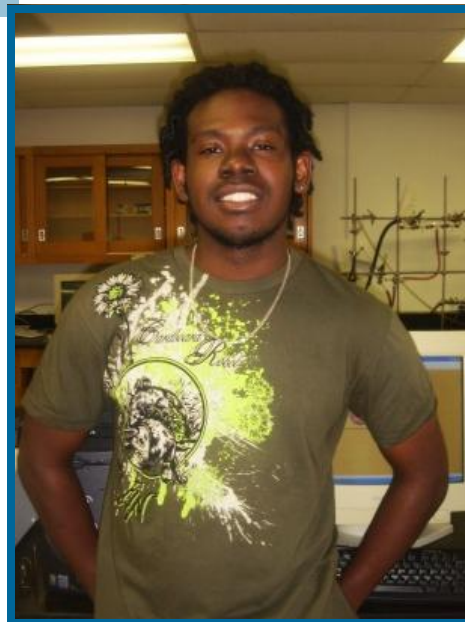
BJ: The proposal fits well with my schedule since it's in the afternoon after my classes are finished.
