PROGRAM PURPOSE:

The program will provide two core activities:

- 1) Instruction in new humanistic scholarship from the perspectives of African American Studies
- 2) Workshops to enhance preparation for graduate school (topics include conducting independent research, the application process, funding graduate school, and preparing a CV)

ELIGIBILITY:

- * Juniors, seniors, and students who have just completed a BA who have not yet begun their first year of a graduate school program.
- * Students who may want to pursue an MA or PhD in the Humanities or Social Sciences (e.g., History, English, Art History, Political Science, Afro-American Studies, Women's Studies, and Sociology).
- * Areas not eligible: Law, Psychology, Science, Business and other social science fields not listed above.
- * Students from Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) are strongly encouraged to apply.
