

Graduate Admissions Checklist:

Students who are applying to the University's Master's or Doctoral programs must submit the following to be considered for admission to Xavier:

- A Graduate Application;
- All official college/university transcripts, including undergraduate and graduate work;
- Two letters of recommendations for Education and Counseling programs, and three letters of recommendations for the Theology program;
- Scores from the GRE or MAT;
- Praxis scores for Education students; plus for Doctoral applicants, a valid teaching certificate where applicable;
- For education Master's, a one-page written essay on why you have chosen your proposed program of study; for Doctoral applicants, a letter of intent and a sample research paper;
- Phone interviews will be conducted for Master's of Theology applicants and interviews will also be conducted for Master's in Counseling and Doctoral applicants.
