² Xavier's graduation rate is actually 49% when student losses due to Hurricane Katrina are included in the calculations. Xavier lost 235 students from the class of 2004 because of Katrina; 114 of these students went on to attain degrees at other institutions.

³ "New Freshman Athlete" is defined as student who received Athletic Aid during first semester of attendance.

⁴ Please note all members of Basketball 2004 new freshman cohort were Black.

⁵ Other sports teams are Cross Country (Men, Women), Tennis (Men, Women), and Volleyball (Women). Please note all members (except for one) were Black.

⁶ "Other ethnicities" includes American Indian/Alaskan Native, Hawaiian/Pacific Islander, and Multiracial.
