 - Health immunizations, insurance and clearance requirements**
There are several legally required immunizations and mandatory university health clearance requirements for college students. Remember, students who wish to register for fall classes during Lagniappe weekend must have completed all health clearance requirements as described at www.xula.edu/student-health/health_requirements.php.
 - Submit a FAFSA** (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
If you have not already done so, complete the FAFSA on the Web by accessing www.fafsa.ed.gov. For more information, contact the Office of Financial Aid.

Selected for Verification

If your FAFSA file is selected for verification, you must submit a copy of your parents and your (if applicable) **2011 IRS tax transcript**. The transcript can be requested at www.irs.gov or call and request the transcript at 1-800-908-9946. (Expect to receive your tax transcript in 5 – 10 working days.)

Dear Student,

As you prepare for registration at Xavier University, there are two **mandatory requirements** that you must complete and submit to Student Health Service **prior** to registration – Health Clearance and Insurance Information.

1. **Health Clearance** – The Health Assessment Form along with proof of immunizations must be submitted to Student Health Services **prior** to registration.

The Health Assessment Form (Included in the Health Packet)

Tetanus – Should be current through anticipated Xavier graduation date.

MMR #1, MMR#2 or Measles, Mumps, Rubella (2 Doses)

TB (mantoux) Skin Test – Within 6 Months Prior to Registration

Meningococcal Meningitis – Mandatory for all Students

(If vaccine was done before 2006, it must be updated)

Note* Proof of Immunization Records are Mandatory – No Exceptions**

2. **Insurance Information** – All undergraduate students must be enrolled in a health insurance plan, which allows them to be seen in emergency rooms and physicians' offices in the New Orleans area.

Insurance Waiver Form – MUST BE COMPLETED – NO EXCEPTIONS

Students will be charged for Health Insurance if the waiver form on-line is not completed. There will be a deadline for waivers – the dates will be posted on the Xavier website – xula.edu

Attaching a copy of your insurance card to the health assessment form is not considered waiving the insurance fees. In order not to be charged for insurance, the on-line waiver form must be completed.

Remember, many HMO's and PPO's do not provide "out of network" coverage. Check with your insurance carrier to see if you have "out of network" benefits. If not you will need to have the student health insurance coverage. In addition, out of state Medicaid does not cover you in Louisiana. If that is your only insurance coverage, you must enroll in the school's insurance.

Remember – If you belong to an HMO or PPO that will cover you in the New Orleans area, you must know how to contact your primary care physician to obtain referrals if needed and how to use that managed care system.

The school code for Xavier University of Louisiana is 002032.
- ◆ If you intend to enroll at Xavier for the 2012 — 2013 Academic Year, it is important that you access, accept, and submit your 2012 — 2013 award letter through your Banner Web account.
- ◆ If you are **NOT** attending Xavier in the fall, please fax, email, or mail a letter stating that you will not be attending. The letter should contain your first and last name, student identification number or social security number.
- ◆ Financial Aid Advisors will be available at Lagniappe to assist you with completing your FAFSA and understanding the Financial Aid process. If you would like assistance with the FAFSA, please be sure to bring your documents for verification including a copy of the parents' and student's (if applicable) 2011 IRS Tax Transcript.

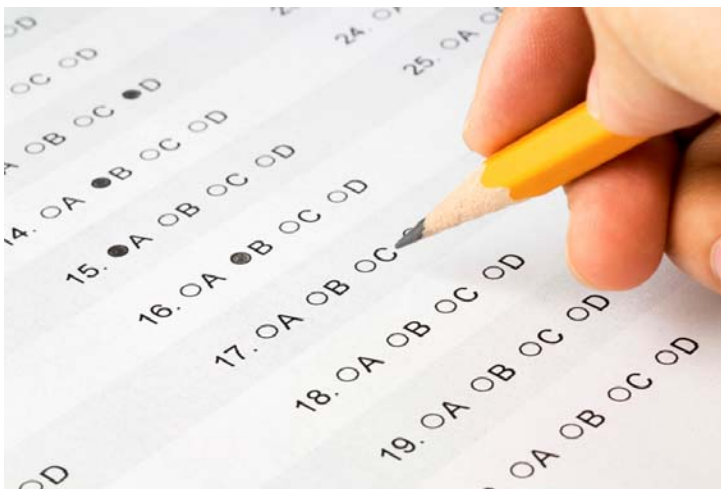




PLACEMENT TESTING AND REGISTRATION



- ◆ The Office of Admissions will notify you if you need to take a placement test and those subjects in which you will be tested.
 - ◆ Placement tests will be offered in English, Mathematics, Reading, French, and Spanish on **Friday, May 25**. If you have registered to attend Lagniappe weekend and you need to take placement tests, you are automatically assigned to take your required tests.
 - ◆ Students will take electronic COMPASS placement tests through ACT.
 - ◆ Students interested in taking practice tests can visit the COMPASS website at www.act.org/compass.
 - ◆ Test results will be available immediately.
 - ◆ Based on test scores, students will receive an updated schedule of their fall courses.

- ◆ If your test scores indicate you need to take developmental courses prior to beginning your degree program, summer developmental courses are available at Xavier.
 - ◆ Registration will be available during Lagniappe Weekend for Summer Session I (May 28 - June 30), Summer Session II (July 2 - August 4) and Summer Session III (June 11 - August 4). Most developmental courses are offered during Summer Session III.
 - ◆ If you have questions about developmental and/or summer courses, speak to your departmental faculty or visit the Registrar's table in the Resource Room.
