DIPLOMAS

DIPLOMAS are awarded at the Commencement Exercises to those who have satisfied ALL requirements for the degree and whose fiscal accounts are clear. Please confirm name change, spelling, etc. with the Office of the University Registrar. If you completed your work last summer or fall and are now out of town, or if for other grave reasons you will be unable to be present for the Commencement Exercises, you must request permission to receive your degree in absentia. Submit your degree application to the Office of the Registrar. (\$124.00 graduation fee will be assessed for CAS graduates & masters, and a \$153.00 fee will be assessed for COP/ Ed.D graduates).

If you are not participating in commencement, submit a “Letter of Absentia” along with a fee of \$34.00 to your College Dean’s Office immediately. In absentia, graduates are ineligible to receive Admission Tickets.

COMMENCEMENT ENTRANCE/ACCESS

Commencement Entrance and seating for the general public at the Convocation Center will be on a first-come, first-served basis. **ALL GUESTS MUST HAVE A TICKET TO ENTER.** Doors open at 7 a.m. for the 8 a.m. ceremony and 11 a.m. for the 1 p.m. ceremony.

At the completion of the Commencement ceremony, guests are directed to meet graduates outside of the entrance to the Convocation Center. ALL GUESTS ARE ASKED TO WAIT OUTSIDE IN ORDER TO AVOID CONFUSION. THANK YOU!

PARKING

CLEAR BAG POLICY

The following bags are allowed:

XULA CLEAR BAG POLICY

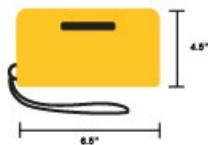
The following policies apply to all events hosted in the Xavier University of Louisiana Convocation Academic Center:

APPROVED ITEMS



Clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"

Diaper bags must also comply with the clear bag policy.



Small clutch bags no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" with or without a handle or strap

PROHIBITED ITEMS



Strollers and infant carriers



Backpacks



Silly string, confetti and balloons



Air horns



Second-line bands



Weapons

All bags are subject to inspection prior to entering the Convocation Academic Center. Items not allowed at the Convocation Academic Center cannot be carried in. Special consideration may be given to parents with infants and those with medical needs.

Any illegal items, or weapons (knives, firearms, objects that could be used as weapons), will be confiscated by security and handed over to local authorities. Second-line bands are prohibited from performing inside the facility or University grounds unless approved by the University.

Police detail and the University Events Team will continuously monitor the event and event attendees. Anyone engaging in a verbal altercation will be required by police detail to exit the event and Xavier grounds immediately. In the event of a physical altercation, police officers will immediately intervene and apprehend all participating parties. Events can be prematurely ended at the discretion of XUPD.

Xavier University of Louisiana is not responsible for items inadvertently left in the facility, theft, damage or loss of vehicle, including articles left within.
