

- All courses will be taught online through the duration of the Spring 2020 semester.
- Advising and student support services will be offered exclusively online.
- Commencement activities will not occur as previously scheduled.
- Students are asked to vacate campus by Friday, March 20, 2020.
- Academic classes are suspended on Thursday, March 19 and Friday, March 20, 2020.
- Online instruction will resume as scheduled on Monday, March 23, 2020.
- It is urgent that you are vigilant about online class attendance.
- The faculty will work with you if you need to leave Wednesday, March 18, 2020.
- You must fill out a Housing Exception Form and return it by Wednesday, March 18, 2020, if you cannot leave by this time.
- Students who have university housing for fall 2020, the credit will be applied towards their fall housing bill.
- Students who leave campus but still have belongings in their dorm room must also complete the form.
- Limited staffing will remain on campus to care for residential students.
- Students will not be able to have guests, nor visit each other hall-to-hall or room-to-room for the duration.
- Students may be relocated to another residence hall as necessary.

- Strict adherence to the Code of Student Conduct is critical during these times.
- Access to facilities and services will be significantly limited.
- Official and unofficial student activities and gatherings will be discontinued.
- A pro-rated credit will be applied for housing and meal plans in accordance with financial aid guidelines.
- Students with an outstanding balance after the application of the housing credit will not receive a refund.
- Students with a negative balance after the application of the housing credit will have a refund deposited.

- Students should complete all enrollment related processes virtually. Registration for summer and fall courses will begin on March 27, 2020, as scheduled.
- Course listings for summer are currently available for review in Banner.
- Course listings for the fall 2020 term are scheduled for release on Friday, March 20th.
