To continue our shared commitment to each other, we are requiring that all students receive their Coronavirus vaccines before returning for the Fall 2021 semester. **Proof of vaccination will be** required for all students planning to attend this fall.

Xavier has partnered with many health providers to make vaccines available to you. This includes DePaul Community Health Center and Tulane University Medical Center. The vaccine being given is the Pfizer vaccine. The Second Dose will be on April 30th on campus. The events above are by appointment only. Please call 844-888-2772 or visit MyOchsner to schedule.

The University will be officially updating its Immunization Requirements for Students to include the COVID-19 vaccine. This health policy update means that, with limited exceptions, all students planning to attend in the Fall 2021 semester must be fully vaccinated unless granted a limited exception for

The benefits of COVID-19 vaccination include prevention of serious illness, hospitalization, and death from the virus. The vaccine also prevents your transmitting the virus to your loved ones. Broad immunization is critical to help stop the current pandemic and to protect our University community. Benefits specific to the Xavier community include:

- · An expedited return to normal operations
- Expanded face-to-face course offerings
- More student life experiences
- Opportunities for a wider range of events and activities offered at our campus
- More normalized pre-pandemic dining and recreation opportunities
- Greater opportunities for personal interactions between faculty, students, and staff that contribute significantly to your success

Xavier has been a leader in providing a safe campus for our community to continue to learn while remaining healthy and safe. The need to stay the course has never been more necessary. An effective vaccination program will make our community safer for all.

Listed below are the directions to complete the plus loan credit check

To Request the Parent PLUS:

- Go to studentaid.gov (secure site)
- Choose "Parent Borrowers" and choose "Apply for a PLUS Loan".
- Sign in using parent FSA ID and password
- Proceed to complete the PLUS Application and read the results.
- Complete the PLUS Loan Agreement- Master Promissory Note (MPN) if you are a first-time borrower or if you have had an endorser on a previous PLUS loan.
- Complete **the XULA Certification Form:** Within three (3) business days after the Direct PLUS loan has been approved, the XULA Financial Aid Office will send XULA certification form to the <u>parent's email address that was provided on the</u> FAFSA.
- Complete, Submit and Return the XULA Certification Form: Once this form is submitted back to the XULA Financial Aid Office the form will be reviewed and the loan will appear as accepted on the student's Banner Web.

If Your PLUS Loan Request Is Denied:

- Appeal the credit decision:
 - O Call Direct Loans at 1-800-557-7394
- O Appeal online at <u>studentaid.gov</u>

 2. Pursue the PLUS with an endorser (cosigner)
- Complete online at <u>studentaid.gov</u>
 Student requests additional unsubsidized loan in lieu of the **PLUS:**
 - O The parent and student are required to complete the Non Co-Endorser Form, which is available on our XULA Financial aid webpage.

Note: The maximum amount of additional unsubsidized loans is up to \$4,000 per year for students with fewer than 90 earned credit hours, and up to \$5,000 per year for students with 90 or more earned credit hours.

- Complete the XULA Certification Form: Within three (3) business days after the Direct PLUS loan has been approved, the XULA Financial Aid Office will send XULA certification form to the <u>parent's email address that</u> was provided on the FAFSA.
- Complete, Submit and Return the XULA Certification Form: Once this form is submitted back to the XULA Financial Aid Office the form will be reviewed and the loan will appear as accepted on the student's Bani

NOTE: Your monthly repayments begin 60 days after the Federal Direct PLUS Loan has been fully disbursed usually after the second spring disbursement. Contact Direct Loan Servicing to inquire about your scheduled monthly repayment plan or to inquire about the possibility of temporarily postponing your monthly repayments (called an administrative forbearance).
