The Pharmacy Pre-Matriculation Summer Program is a four-week summer program that exposes incoming students to professional school environment plus pharmacy coursework! **80% of students** who participate in PPMSP pass all of their Fall courses.

ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT PROGRAM (AEP)
