Team Xavier Scores 11 Trophies at HBCU National Speech and Debate Tournament

New Orleans LA – Team Xavier scored 11 trophies – including one for first place in interviewing and 4th overall in the team sweepstakes – at the first annual Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) National Speech and Debate Tournament, held at Wiley College.

22 HBCUs competed in the event. As a team, Xavier finished 4th overall in combined sweepstakes, with second and fifth place finishes in the debate and speech competitions, respectively.

Alana Humphrey, a senior neuroscience major from Plymouth MIN (Wayzata High), was the top individual performer for Xavier, taking 1st place in interviewing and scoring in singles debate (semifinalist/#3 best speaker). Also taking home trophies in singles debate were: Elin Hawkins, a senior biology/premed major from Moreno Valley CA (Martin L King High), quarterfinalist/#2 best speaker; Kara Hebert, a sophomore mathematics major from San Carlos CA (Sequoia High), semifinalist; and Kristian Bailey, a sophomore biology/premed major from Ama LA (Shaw High), quarterfinalist. Charles Perkins, a freshman mathematics major from Florissant MO (Jennings High), was a semifinalist in Poetry Slam.

Others competing for Team Xavier were Aungelique McGhee, Javonte Vaden, Adrian Johnson, Yailee Bangura, Mya Jacobs, Kingston Robinson, Kyle Grant, Patrick Bell, and Trevor Samuels. Serving as student judges were Gabrielle Massey and Evelyn Major.

Humphrey serves team president and a student coach, while Hawkins is vice president. Dr. James Dunson and Sarah Meier of the Department of Philosophy are serving as coach/faculty advisor and faculty advisor, respectively.
