- Perform research in the state-of-the-art facility for ~10 hours a week and receive a monthly stipend during the academic year (9 months)
- Participate in a 10-week STEM summer research program (June-July) at NASA and receive ~\$4k in stipend with free room and board
- Be a part of a future NASA space mission
- Present your research at national conferences

This is a STEM research-based mentoring and training program that prepares MICHESS students for advanced degrees (MS and PhD) in chemistry, physics, and engineering. To be eligible, you must first be accepted into the MICHESS.
