Placement Policy Spanish 1010, French 1010, and Chinese 1010, and American Sign Language 1010 are for students that have no prior experience studying the language. Students that have studied Spanish, French, Chinese, or American Sign Language previously in elementary or high school should take the placement test. Students will receive three hours of placement credit for the course below the course they placed after earning a C or better in the course. For example, if a student is placed into Spanish 2020, after getting a C or better in the course they will also receive a three-hour placement credit for Spanish 2010.
